### **Local Republicans Endorse Knight, Nutting, Barb and Judge Stracener**

Placerville – Following three months of campaign presentations by all 10 candidates for County Supervisor and 3 candidates for Superior Court Judge, the California Republican Assembly unit of El Dorado County has endorsed John Knight in District I, Ray Nutting in District II, Richard Barb in District III for County Supervisor, and Judge Warren (Curt) Stracener for Superior Court Judge. Reflecting the conservative make-up of El Dorado County, all 13 candidates running for County Supervisor and Judge described themselves as Republicans.
