Assemblyman Dan Logue Endorses Richard Barb For Supervisor In District III

State Capitol, CA – Influential small business advocate, Assemblyman Dan Logue has endorsed independent business owner Richard Barb for Supervisor in El Dorado County’s hotly contested District III race.
