Endorsements Reach 1,000 Mark For Richard Barb In District III Supervisor Race

Placerville, CA – Richard Barb’s campaign today reached the lofty 1,000 endorsement mark, including nearly 150 individual businesses in El Dorado County’s red hot District III race. This announcement comes on the heels of recent FPPC Campaign Disclosure Reports filed with County Elections showing Barb’s fundraising lead widening. Few elections in El Dorado County history have featured candidates earning 1,000 or more endorsements.

“Richard Barb’s amazing outpouring of support from individuals and businesses is phenomenal”, said John Stelzmiller a former Republican Central Committee Chairman and longtime observer of local elections, “the only other candidate I can remember receiving 1,000 endorsements is Sheriff D’Agostini in 2010”.

“I’m particularly surprised at the large number of businesses openly endorsing Richard Barb”, said Stelzmiller, “this proves my contention that this race is a referendum about who can best fix our broken business climate and create good-paying jobs for working families”.

“The question voters are asking themselves is - *who is better to fix our local economy and create good jobs, a business owner or a lifetime Government employee?*” explained Stelzmiller, “and they are realizing that a business owner like Richard Barb is the better choice”.

Richard Barb’s growing list of endorsements includes: the *National Tax Limitation Committee, Gun Owners of America, California Taxpayer Protection Committee, Gun Owners of California, California Republican Assembly, Region Builders*, Senator Don Rogers (Ret.), Senator H.L. Richardson (Ret.), Assemblyman Dan Louge, former Sheriff Hal Barker, former Undersheriff Ernie Hillman and approximately 150 individual businesses.
