Senator Don Rogers Endorses Richard Barb For Supervisor In District III

Diamond Springs, CA – Tax fighting former Senator Don Rogers has endorsed independent business owner Richard Barb for Supervisor in the hotly contested District III race. Senator Rogers, who now lives in Diamond Springs, is most famous for sponsoring the ballot initiative which successfully abolished California’s Inheritance (or death) Tax.

Richard Barb was recently endorsed by the *National Tax Limitation Committee* and the organization’s President Lewis K. Uhler. The election is June 5.
